WHEREAS the Boy Scouts of America was incorporated by Mr. William D. Boyce on February 8, 1910; and

WHEREAS the Boy Scouts of America was founded to promote citizenship, training, personal development and fitness of individuals; and

WHEREAS Thomas Alejandro Alvarado is a resident of the South Anna Magisterial District in Hanover County, Virginia, and a junior at Patrick Henry High School; and

WHEREAS on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015, Thomas Alejandro Alvarado attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest award granted by the Boy Scouts of America; and
